After the May half term, **starting Tuesday 6th June**, we are opening our new Breakfast Club and After School Club for Cockfield school children only. If you are interested in booking a place please get in touch. We will require at least 48 hours' notice to reserve a slot. Breakfast Club will be available from 7.45-8.45am at a cost of £3.50. After school 3.20pm - 5.50pm will attract a charge of £7.50. For one hour the cost is £4.50. If you would like the first hour and part of a second hour (for example 3.20- 5pm) the charge would still be £7.50. The clubs will be run by existing members of staff. Breakfast would include a choice of juice and toast, or fruit and yoghurt. After school a drink and biscuit would be provided. If your child would like to attend a sports club first and then come along to after school care that will be fine too and be charged according to the cost of the club plus £4.50. To begin with we will be operating the Breakfast Club on five mornings and the After School Club - Monday to Thursday. This will be on school days only and will not include PD Days.
