Early Help Offer

“Early Help’ describes the type of early intervention and support that can be provided when a child or young person’s needs are not being met by routine universal services, but do not meet the threshold for a specialist service such as Children’s Social Care.

The Early Help Offer is about working with partners to help children, young people and families deal with their issues as early as possible; providing information, advice and services at the right time; supporting them to resolve their concerns as needs emerge.

Our Early Help Offer includes:

- Nurture Group
- Breakfast Club
- Learning Together sessions
- Induction sessions for children starting Reception class
- The school’s nursing team
- Signs of Safety toolkit
- In house safeguarding protocols (DSL Mrs Harkin, ASL Miss Perkins, named Governor, Mrs Jo Walton)
- External agency support (Behaviour support, CISS, Suffolk Parent Hub www.suffolk.gov.uk/theparenthub Counselling, Child Specific Interventions, CAF, FSP)
- ‘Reading Dog’ programme
- Bespoke learning interventions e.g. reading, maths, phonics
- Termly Emotional Wellbeing Days that provide support for the children’s mental health, gauge children’s perseverance, attitude to learning, self-esteem & relationships with peers and family.
