Review of Pupil Premium Spend 2017/2018

Allocation £22440 Number of children 12 + 5 Ever 6

How we spent the funding to support our Pupil Premium children:

Improving the outcomes in maths through the purchase of Inspire Maths and the development of Mastery Maths - £3200

- Purchase of Inspire online tool, pupil books, teacher books, practice books.
- CPA resources – diennes etc
- Training for staff PD Day
- EYFS training – Solve Ed, course and supply cover
- Visit from Liz Gibbs – trainer
- Attendance at maths meetings and subject co-ordinator days.
- TA training
- Maths Day with parents

Maths outcomes –

Y6 6/7 children 86% met expectations in the end of year SATs assessments

Greater Depth 1/7 14%

Y2 – 12/15 children 80% met expected standard in end of year assessments

Greater Depth 2/15 children 13%

EYFS – 6/8 75% of children achieved maths ELG

Pupil Premium/Ever 6 children –

Y6 3/7 children 2 out of 3 met expectations

Y2 5/15 children 4 out of 5 met expectations

EYFS 2/8 children 1 out of 2 met expectations

Allocated LSA to support the needs of identified pupils with additional needs – social and pastoral support for identified pupils. Lunch time club and afternoon sessions twice a week. £7860

Outcomes – improved attendance for one child moving from 75% to 86%.

One child was able to stop hiding under tables, use break system and support network, securing better learning and no exclusions in the summer term.

Children from disadvantaged families given equal access to trips, visits and visitors along with clubs- £525

Outcome- Teachers agree that children enthused with regards to their learning, adds value to each individual's academic and personal development.

Mental Health and Wellbeing days – Young Minds training- supply cover, Drawing and Learning Course, yoga and meditation, whole school trip to woods, visits and visitors, staff training. Attendance at mental health workshops termly, additional TA hours. £620.

Outcome- Children report that they find these days enjoyable, valuable and supportive in their feedback.

Early intervention to maximise pupil outcomes – information parent meetings, tapestry on-line Learning journey, Purchase of book bags/PE bags, unexpected uniform needs- PE kits and school sweatshirts. £123 & £130.

Y6 SATs revision guides for use at home. £52.50



SATs boosters and interventions, February to May, additional PE coverage for Y2 and Y6 £720

Healthy free school meal provided to all eligible children. £2.30 x 5 days x 38 weeks x 17 = £7429

Outcome – improved concentration during afternoon lessons and classroom behaviour -School Food Trust 2009 An intervention study

Behaviour and welfare support for identified children – Breakfast offered to children who have behavioural issues/ lack of concentration and focus – ‘hangry’ – Psychology Today 3/5/17 £30

Total to date= £20,689.50

Some costs not yet received

Half termly Pupil progress meetings have focused on what is having the most impact. The Head teacher has joined a support for school’s project looking at the progress of disadvantaged pupils. Closer tracking of disadvantaged pupils has made our provision more tailored to the needs of the child.
