### Sports Premium Impact Report 2017/2018 – £16530

- Promoting outdoor activities – equipment and resources improved to promote physical activity. Gym trail equipment, storage boxes for new equipment and outdoor games. Course for MDSA. Targeting groups such as KS1 girls in ball skills and team games. Children active and keeping fit during playtimes and lunchtimes £433
- PE equipment repairs and enhancements for increased gym. £893
- Sports Day rewards, stickers/stopwatches to include all children. £63
- Dance upskilling, dance in Birch and Oak class. Impact: led to performance at Christmas, as well as high levels of engagement in dance club which ran all year round due to popularity. More confident and competent staff. Enhanced quality of teaching and learning. £420
- Special days – World Cup resources and celebrations, activities days, yoga, wellbeing days - £76 + £284. Impact - good citizenship promoted, pupil concentration, commitment and self-esteem enhanced. Engagement of disaffected pupils.
- AG&T and hard to reach children – new sports/activity days – parkour, karate etc £200. This has encouraged two children in year 6 to take sports outside of school and improved the confidence of two Y6 boys who do not attend clubs but one has now shown a more positive attitude to PE.
- Subsidised sports club and hire of hall for yoga. School support has made clubs accessible and uptake has increased by more than 25%. Pupil interviews and questionnaires have signalled an improved positive attitude to health and wellbeing. £1762
  
- New breakfast table tennis club – 38 weeks = £2185
- Swimming - opened up to the whole of KS2 and Y6 swimming extended to support achievement. An inclusive curriculum provision has increased pupil participation. All Year 6 pupils (7 children) achieved 25m and a range of strokes along with the lifesaving award. £1793
- Silver membership of sports partnership & transport for festivals and sports competitions. Impact - Increased pupil participation in competitive activities, improved behaviour and enhanced communication with parents. £750
- Grounds care – field maintenance, grass cutting and line markings, football, rounders, athletics. £1920
