Phonics

Reception - Listening skills and activities until appropriate to begin the Jolly Phonics programme.

Year 1 - Revision of sounds and tricky words learnt so far before learning new sounds.

Literacy

Reception will be focusing on speaking in full sentences, listening to stories, predicting how they might end and recognising familiar words, including our own names.

Year 1 will be practicing careful segmenting for spelling and writing sentences that include a capital letter, fingers spaces and full stop.

We will also create some poetry using the stimulus *Magic*.

Science

What makes you different and unique?

Seasonal change including: weather, observational walks and hibernation.

Everyday materials including their properties and uses.

Music

Maths songs, nursery rhymes, using our voices and Christmas Nativity songs.

History/Geography

Changes within living memory and important events in your life. Local geography, seasonal change and the countries and capital cities of the UK.

PSHE

Friendships and Relationships - My feelings, my body and my relationships.

Drugs, alcohol and tobacco - medicines and keeping safe. Learning together workshop.

Computing

We will be learning how to log on to the laptops and begin mouse and keyboard skills.

PE

Dance - using the story of *Superworm* to move confidently through the space.

Games - key skills.

Reception will also have balance bikes for 5 weeks.

Art

Developing skills in line, shape and colour by drawing and painting self-portraits. We will repeat the activity in the summer term to see how our skills have improved.

DT

We will design, make and evaluate a product linked to our class story.

Belonging - Christianity and Judaism.
