### Sports Premium Impact Report 2018/2019 – £16810

- Promoting outdoor activities – equipment and resources improved to promote physical activity. Gym trail equipment, storage boxes for new equipment and outdoor games. Children active and keeping fit during playtimes and lunchtimes £250
- PE equipment repairs and enhancements for increased gym. £1200
- Sports Day rewards, stickers/stopwatches to include all children. £72
- Special days/workshops – Parkour Day, Balance Bikes, BMX workshop, Basketball coaching day, yoga, wellbeing days – Wet and Wild in woods. £1750. Impact - good citizenship promoted, pupil concentration, commitment and self-esteem enhanced. Engagement of disaffected pupils.
- AG&T and hard to reach children – new sports/activity days – parkour, karate etc £200. This has encouraged two children in year 6 to take sports outside of school and improved the confidence of two Y6 boys who do not attend clubs but one has now shown a more positive attitude to PE.
- Subsidised sports club and hire of hall for yoga. School support has made clubs accessible and uptake has increased by more than 20%. Pupil interviews and questionnaires have signalled an improved positive attitude to health and wellbeing. £3200
- Bike Ability – 4 days' x 2 groups = £800 12 out of 14 children passed
- Purchase of PE kits for all year groups so lost/absent kit does not top participation = £82
- African Adventure subsidised for 4 children in Upper KS2 - £480
- Breakfast Active Club – 38 weeks = £2400, attendance has marginally increased
- Swimming - opened up to the whole of KS2 and Y6 swimming extended to support achievement. An inclusive curriculum provision has increased pupil participation. All Year 6 pupils (15 children) achieved 25m and a range of strokes along with the lifesaving award. £1800
- Silver membership of sports partnership & transport for festivals and sports competitions. Impact - Increased pupil participation in competitive activities, improved behaviour and enhanced communication with parents. £950 plus £720 for transport
- Grounds care – field maintenance, grass cutting and line markings, football, rounders, athletics. £1920
- New playground markings to promote activity in lessons, French, maths etc. £600
