History/Geography

Mini Geog Topic - Revision sessions - Countries and cities of the UK. **Introduce continents and oceans.** Name and locate the world's seven continents and five oceans.

- Addition and subtraction of numbers within 100 and then 1000.

Materials and their properties

- Building on learning in Year 1 about what materials are we will be:
- Identifying and comparing the suitability of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard for particular uses
- Find out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.

Art/DT

In DT we will be constructing model castles using paper and card. We will look at the features of castles before planning our own. We will look at different ways to join materials to make sure they are secure.

In art this term we will focus on textiles and on painting. Our focus artist will be Gainsborough.
