Sports Premium Impact Report 2019/2020 – £16740

- Promoting outdoor activities – equipment and resources improved to promote physical activity. £250
- PE equipment repairs and enhancements – netball, gym equipment etc £600
- In class Sports Day rewards, stickers/stopwatches to include all children. £72
- Special days/workshops – Skip 2b Fit resulted in the purchase of a skipping rope for all children. Daily skipping and weekly challenges has resulted in improved fitness. At sports day the skipping challenges were too easy. £780
- Circus skills workshop resulted in greater participation at lunchtime of circus skills and additional resources purchased. Workshop and resources = £520
- Basketball Workshop and basketball coaching day led to an uptake in basketball club and upskilling in PE lessons. Children entered local competition and came third. £250
- Yoga, balance bikes & wellbeing days – Wet and Wild in woods. £1200. Impact - good citizenship promoted, pupil concentration, commitment and self-esteem enhanced. Engagement of disaffected pupils. Improved co-ordination and gross motor skills.
- Subsidised sports club and hire of hall for yoga. School support has made clubs accessible and uptake has increased by more than 20%. Pupil interviews and questionnaires have signalled an improved positive attitude to health and wellbeing. £3200
- Purchase of PE kits for all year groups so lost/absent kit does not top participation = £82
- Breakfast Active Club – 38 weeks = £2400, attendance has marginally increased
- Swimming – unable to complete due to COVID, but a contribution to Suffolk Norse was required £800
- Silver membership of sports partnership & transport for festivals and sports competitions. Impact - Increased pupil participation in competitive activities, improved behaviour and enhanced communication with parents. £950 plus £750 for transport cross country, activities days in KS2.
- Grounds care – field maintenance, grass cutting and line markings, football, rounders, athletics. £1920

= £13,774 spent, carry forward £2966 (Reduced spend due to COVID)
