Reading	<p>Practice a random selection of your Phonic Fairy sounds and Tricky Troll words.</p> <p>Read 3 of the sentences in your pack.</p> <p>Daily reading of your reading book or another book from home. 😊</p>	<p>Last week, you looked at the front cover of the book <i>The Way Back Home</i> by Oliver Jeffers. He didn't remember leaving it there, how do you think it got there? What did he decide to do after he found the object in his cupboard? Draw a picture to show what the little boy did. Writing	<p>Practise forming the tall letters, making sure that you start each lower-case letter with an entry line. Pick one letter to practise each day.</p>	<p>After you have done the science lesson below and have been on your winter walk, can you write down what you saw, heard, felt and smelled? Challenge: Write in full sentences with finger spaces between words, a capital letter at the beginning and a full stop at the end. There are some winter sheets in your pack.</p>	<p>Activity 1 Ask your grown up to hide these pictures around the house. When you find a picture you can collect it, take the pictures back to your table and practise counting the sounds that you can hear in the word. Use your alphabet mat and sound mats to help you to write the words down.</p>
Maths	<p>Practise forming the numbers 0-9. Choose two numbers to practise each day.</p>	<p>Zoom lesson with Miss Fairless - Monday 25th 10am We have been learning how to make the numbers to 6. For this game you will need a big container, like a bucket, and 6 small balls or beanbags. Decide where you will stand and throw your bean bags at the bucket. How many landed inside and how many landed on the floor? Say and write the addition sentence to match your turn.
