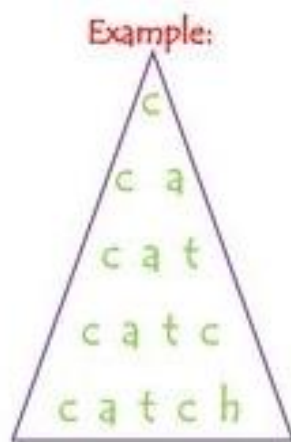


## Spelling Practice Ideas

1. Rainbow spellings: Write each word in the colours of the rainbow - you could even write in a rainbow shape if you would like to.



2. Pyramid spellings: start with the first letter of the word and add one more letter on for each layer of the pyramid.



3. Build it: make your spellings using any letters you have at home. Magnetic letters or foam letters would work well.



4. Spelling hunt: ask your grown up to hide some of your spellings around the house. Leave a piece of paper and a pencil on the table while you hunt for your spellings. When you find a word, you need to remember it in your head, go back to your paper and write it down. You could even give yourself a time limit to make it more challenging.

5. Silly sentences: pick a word and come up with a silly sentence containing that word, then write your sentence down.
