Writing	<p>Practise spelling 3 Tricky Troll words each day. Make sure you are forming your letters correctly and starting with entry lines.</p>	<p>Cut out the pictures from the story <i>The Way Back Home</i> and put them in order.</p> <p>Write a sentence for each picture to tell the story. Remember to count the sounds you can hear in each word before writing it. Use your alphabet mat, sound mat and tricky word mat to help you. I have also put a space word mat in your pack as lots of space words can't be sounded out. 
