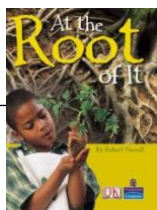
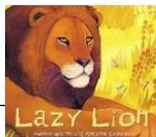


Oak Class

Special days

We are planning a trip to the beach with Lime Class. We will also be celebrating the Queen's Platinum Jubilee.

Science

In science this half term we are learning about plants and how they grow. We will look at the different parts of plants and the jobs they do. In the second half term we will look at animals and their habitats, including why animals are well suited to the habitats in which they live.

To support your child, you could talk about the plants you have in your garden or plants you see when out on a walk.

You could try planting some of your own seeds at home.

You could talk about different habitats you see around the village - eg pond, meadow, woodland etc.

Literacy

Our book this half term is 'At the root of it' which links with our science learning on plants. Next half term we will be looking at African tales.

We will really be focussing on making sure that all writing has correct punctuation and is all written in the same tense. We will look at different sentence types - statement, command, question and exclamation and try to use all of these in our writing. We will look at how fiction and non-fiction writing is different and practising our writing skills across the curriculum.

In reading we will look at both fiction and non-fiction. We will look at retrieving information from the text and also inferring meaning from the text - for example working out how characters are feeling from the way they are behaving in a story.

To support your child at home please read with them **5 or more times** a week and practise their spellings with them each week - spelling checks will be on a Monday., You will also find the Year 2 tricky words towards the back of your child's reading diary - these are the words they should be able to **read and spell** by the end of Year 2.

Maths

This term we will be focussing on fractions, and revisiting multiplication and division including solving problems. We will also look at telling the time and measuring. We will put our measuring skills to the test as part of our plant growing topic.

In problem solving we will look at missing number problems for example $3 \times ? = 12$ or $37 - ? = 19$.

To support your child at home, please continue to support them in accessing TT Rockstars every week. In addition, please work on the maths targets that are alongside this letter. There are some number facts that children need to know off by heart to support their problem solving skills and regular practise will really help with this.

Music
