Parents Survey Dec 2019 - Analysis of
Results

Introduction

- Questionnaire asked 18 direct questions, plus asked parents to state their child's favourite subjects, and whether the parents would recommend Cockfield school to other parents
- Responses received from 25 families
- Slideset is grouped into 5 sections, in line with the survey:
 - Behaviour & Safety
 - Curriculum & Learning
 - Communication
 - Family Involvement
 - Favourite subjects

Summary

- **All Responses**

- 91% strongly agree or agree with the question statements; 2% disagree, 0% strongly disagree
- This is a very pleasing result
- **100% said they would recommend the school to other parents**
- 100% said there were good opportunities to learn new skills outside the classroom
- 100% said the school website/newsletter were useful sources of information
- Highest level of disagreement was re. homework; 16% said amount inappropriate
- 4% (1 respondent in cash case) disagreed that the school supported children's wider personal development, and that concerns raised with school had been dealt with properly

- **Parents' Comments**

- 13 commented: 6 expressed satisfaction, and in some cases extreme satisfaction, with the school
- **Concerns raised:**
 - Sugar in lunches and Wow! Party cakes
 - Homework relating to work not yet taught in class
 - Disagreement with ban on photos of children
 - Request for more detailed notes in books where child uses school bus = no direct teacher contact e.g. in playground
 - 1 parent said they had only ever received 1 newsletter
 - Request to have more school assemblies in the afternoon
 - Request for more technology to be used in class

Behaviour & Safety

- 1 parent said their child was not happy at school but stressed this was due to domestic situation and thanked Headteacher and Governors for support – said they were “overwhelmed by the support given to their child by Mrs Harkin in a pastoral way”
- **Otherwise, no parent disagreed with any of the 5 statements**
- My child is happy at school – 92% agree
- My child feels safe at school – 96% agree
- Someone to listen if child has a problem – 96% agree
- School makes sure pupils are well-behaved – 88% agree
- School deals quickly with behaviour issues – 92% agree

Curriculum & Learning

- My child does well at this school – 92% agree, 0% disagree
- Appropriate amount of homework is more contentious; 72% agree and 16% disagree (4 respondents)
- School has high expectations for my child – 80% agree, 0% disagree
- School supports my child's wider personal development - 84% agree, 4% disagree (1 respondent)
- Good range of subjects available – 96% agree, 0% disagree
- Good opportunities to learn new experiences/skills outside the classroom – 100% agree

Communication

- Effective communication re. progress – 96% agree, 0% disagree
- Effective communication re. supporting learning – 92% agree, 0% disagree
- School makes me aware of what child is learning – 92% agree, 0% disagree
- Concerns raised with school have been dealt with properly – 72% agree, 4% disagree
- School newsletter/website are useful sources of information – 100% agree

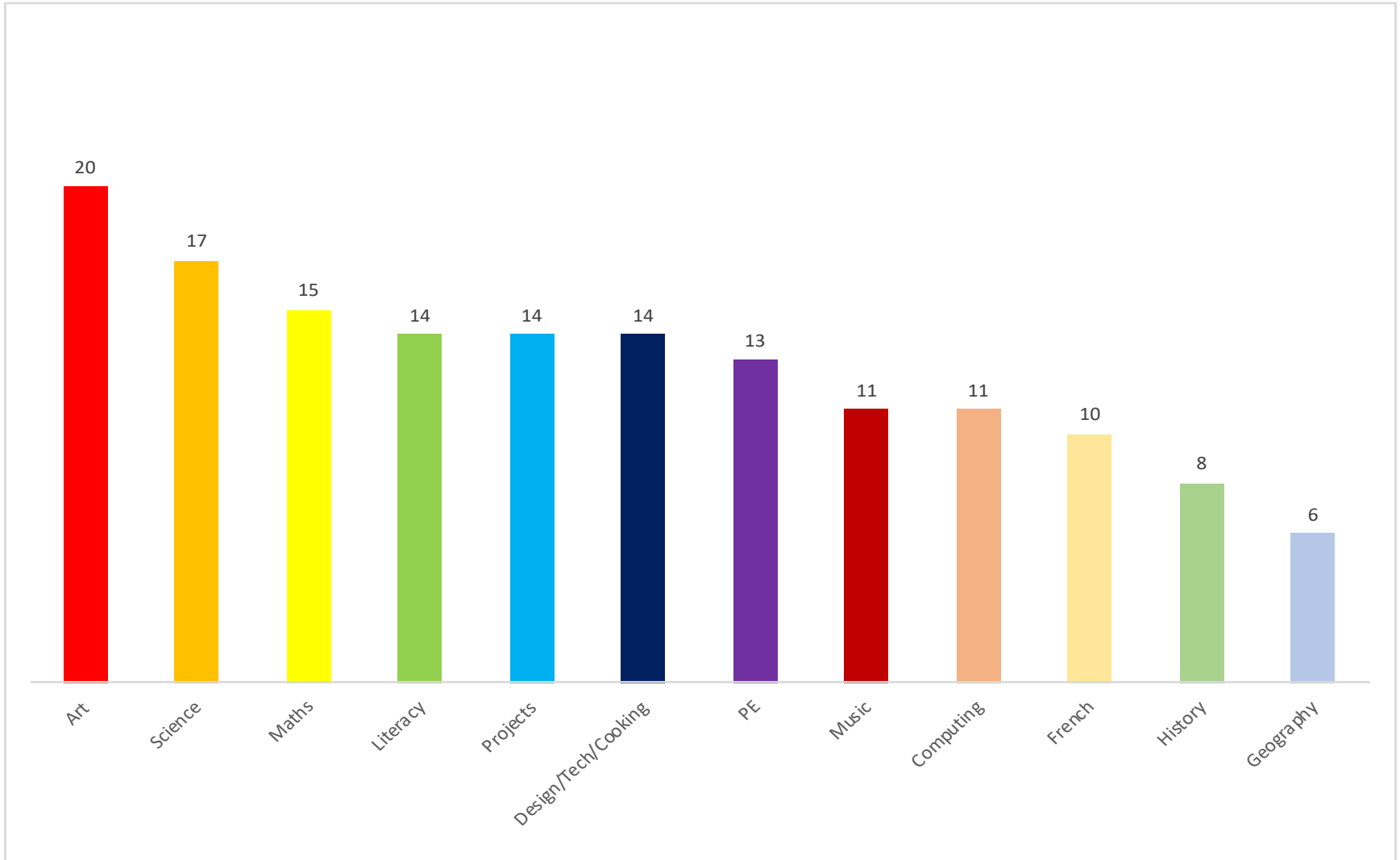
Family Involvement

Favourite Subjects

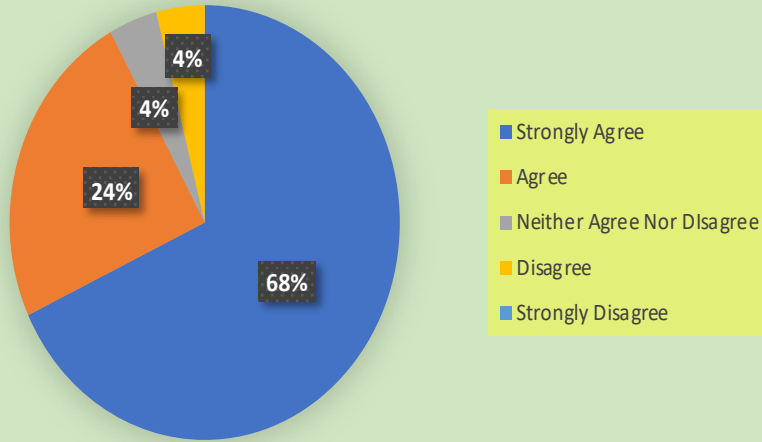
- Art most popular, as it was last time

Favourite Subjects 2019

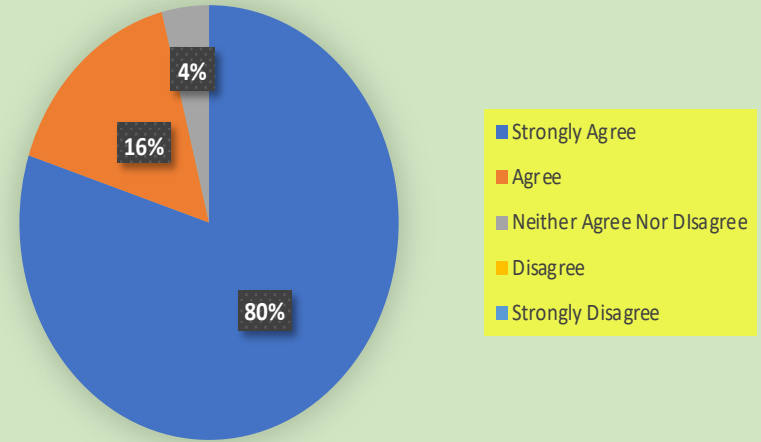


Behaviour & Safety (1)

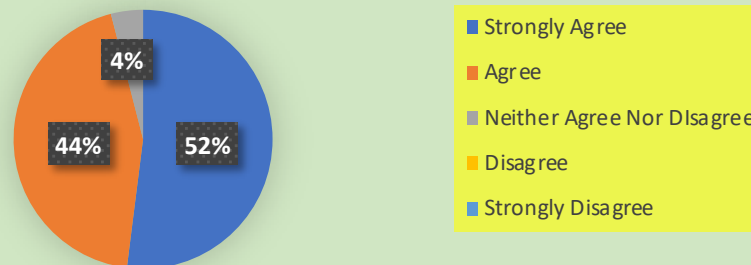
My child is happy at this school



My child feels safe at this school

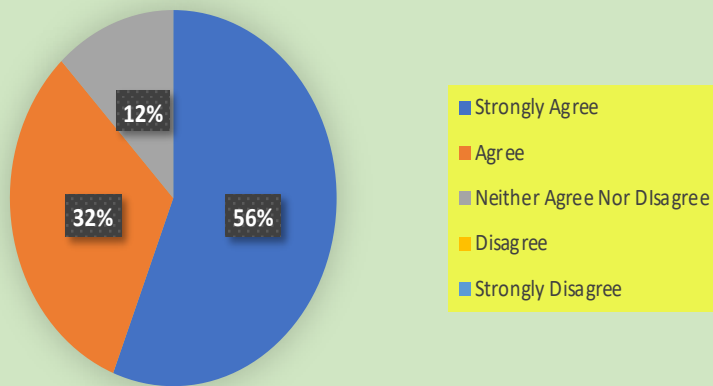


My child is confident that should they have a problem, there is someone they can go to in school who will listen to them

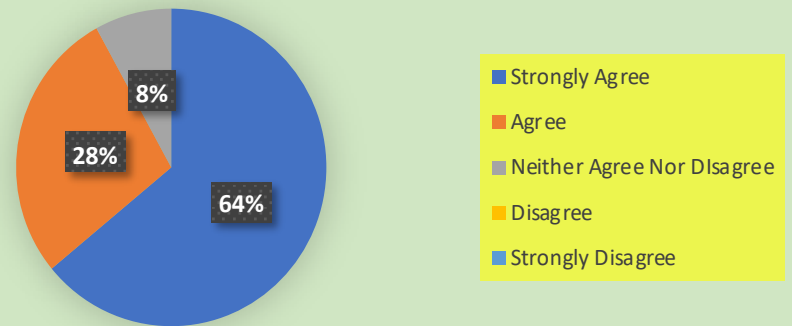


Behaviour & Safety (2)

The school makes sure its pupils are well behaved

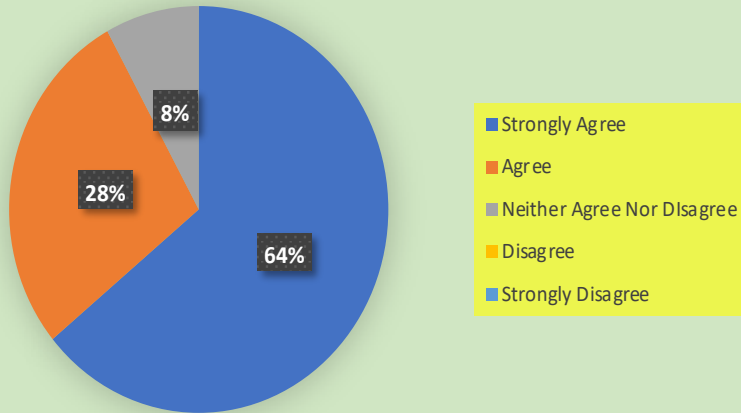


The school deals with any issues with behaviour or concerns quickly and effectively

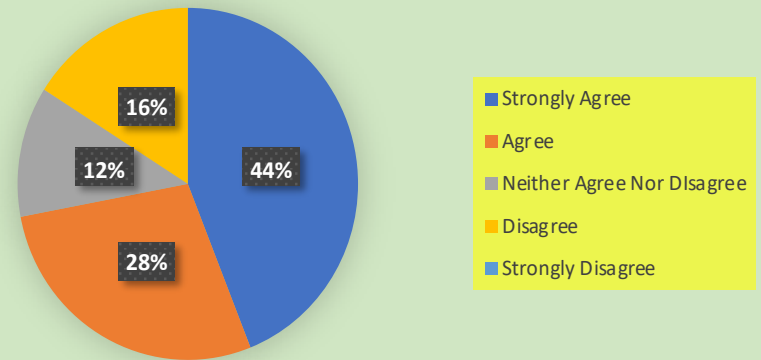


Curriculum & Learning (1)

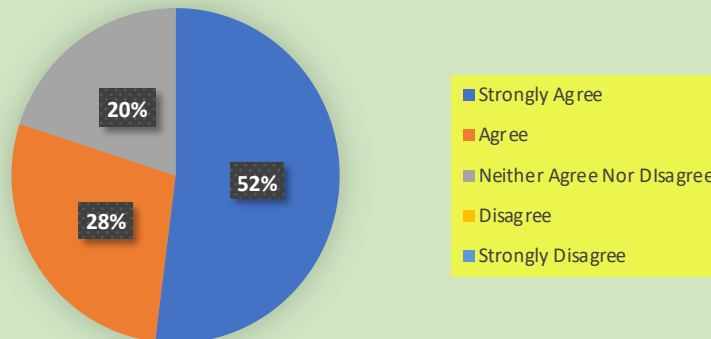
My child does well at this school

Cockfield CEVC Primary School has high expectations for my child

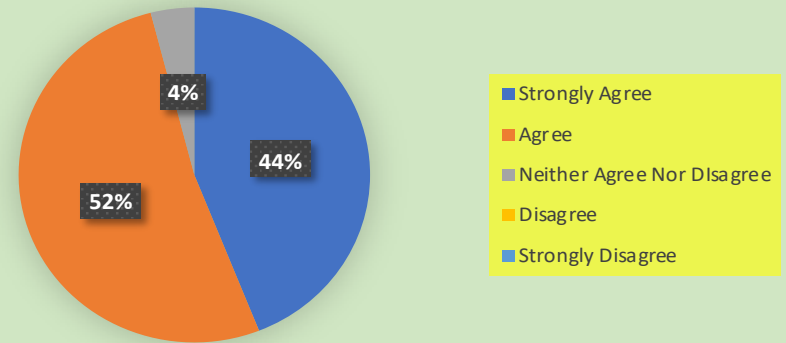

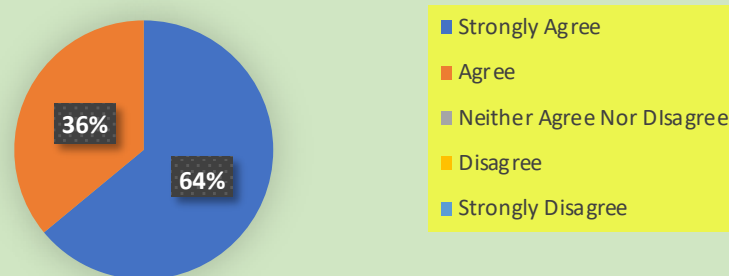
The school supports my child's wider personal development



There is a good range of subjects available to my child at this school

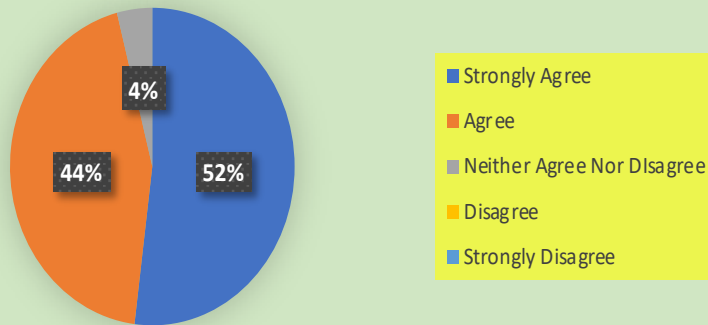


The school provides good opportunities for my child to learn new experiences and skills outside the classroom

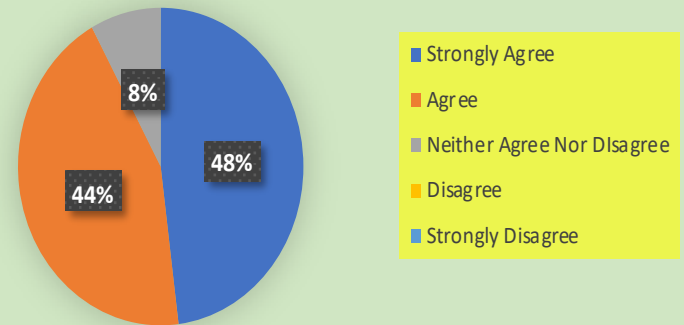


Communication (1)

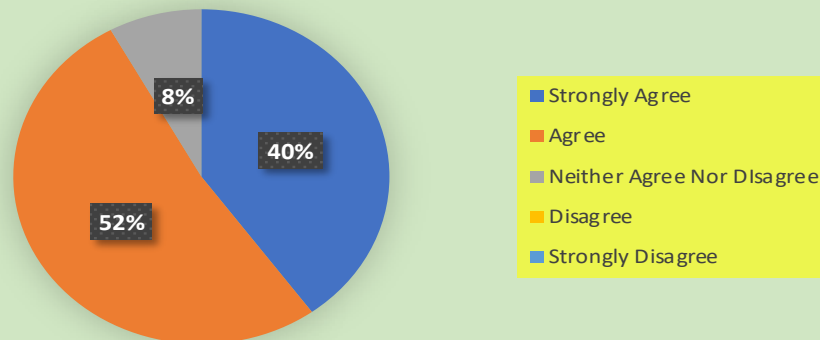
The school communicates effectively with me about my child's progress- postcards, Wow, parent evenings



The school communicates with me effectively about how to support my child's learning

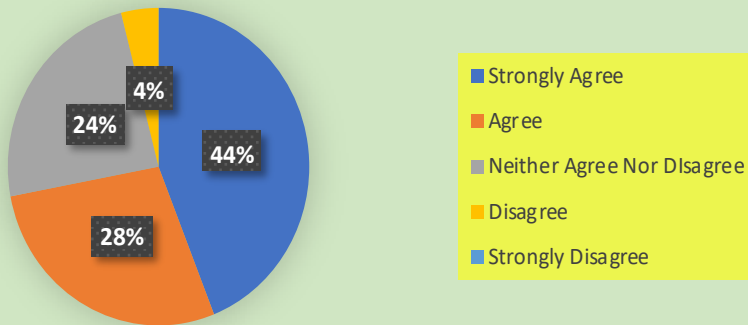


The school makes me aware of what my child will learn during the year

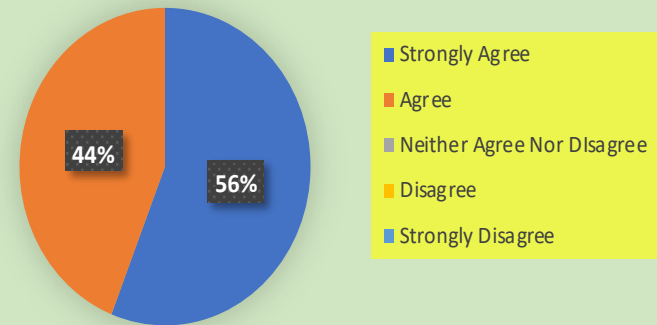


Communication (2)

When I have raised concerns with the school they have been dealt with properly

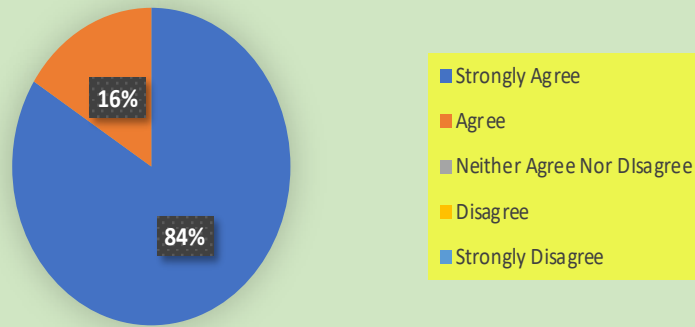


I find the school newsletter and website to be useful sources of information about the school
