Dear Parents/carers,

Thank you for your support with our **Break the Rules Day** last week. The children enjoyed changing their names, styling their hair and wearing make-up etc! The day raised £138 for FOCSA. Thank you to those who donated.

Some extra WOWs to mention this half term- I have been really impressed with Year 4 spelling- impressive results these past few weeks running!

Lilly in Year 6 has gained a place in the Eastern Region tumble squad, an amazing achievement plus Lilly has been picked for the Suffolk Squad! What a talented young lady, focussed and determined.

I have enjoyed hearing about some impressive comments from the children in assemblies, Letia Fred and Jemma really wowed me on the subject of environmental change and how we have a responsibility to look after nature! School Council have challenged the Parish Council about littering in the car park and rubbish that blows into our school. They will be helping the village with a litter pick next month.

Learning Powers - We have been challenging the children to think about how they can motivate themselves, engage in, and improve their learning. We call this metacognition. We will want Parents to help with this at home, when supporting reading and homework. Rather than giving your child an answer, can they solve the problem they have? What strategies can they call on at home? We talk about our Learning Power animals. Kelly the Koala - she asks questions, thinks of possible reasons, is curious, creative. Emily the Elephant - she manages distractions, concentrates, focuses on one thing at a time, breaking things into smaller steps. Albert the Armadillo is resilient, excited to try new things, does not worry if it goes wrong. Sadie the Squirrel listens to others co-operates, is tolerant, explains things to help others. The monkeys Martin and Malvin focus on self-improving, tries to be better than last time, does not compare themselves to anybody else. We will be sharing a summary sheet with you at Parent Evening too. Don't forget to sign up for Parents evenings which are immediately after half term.
